Chablis Côte de Léchet 1er Cru

The full and ripe citrus nose is matched by the same character on the quite expansive, creamy palate. A touch of caramel, but it remains so fresh and the long finish is decisively dry. Drink or hold.

Chablis Montée de Tonnerre 1er Cru

Very classic nose with delicate citrus-blossom and floral-honey notes. Very elegant with a finely etched medium body and a very long, salty yet refined finish. Just beginning to open up. Drink or hold.

Chablis Les Clos Grand Cru

Stunning depth and ripeness with slightly exotic character (flowers, herbs and fruit), plus some melted butter. Full-bodied, but very elegant, the intense minerality driving this along. Intense, salty finish. Drink or hold.

Chablis Fourchaume 1er Cru

This has the chalky minerality and the touch of austerity you expect from Chablis, but also super balance of ripe and fresh components that glide gracefully over the palate. Long, delicately salty finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

Chablis Montmains 1er Cru

Brimming with ripe citrus and discreet oak, plus a touch of flint, making this an immediately appealing Chablis 1er. Nice, creamy texture on the mid-palate, then it glides into a long, salty-mineral finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

Chablis Preuses Grand Cru

Lovely orange-blossom nose with a ripe-orange note that slowly emerges as it aerates. Then freshly mown meadows. Concentrated and elegant with tons of chalky and salty minerality, making this a very classic Chablis. Drink or hold.

Chablis Mont de Milieu 1er Cru

Attractive balance of creaminess and ripe acidity on the medium-bodied palate. Lovely interplay of floral-honey and chalky character on the generous finish. Drink or hold.

Chablis Vaillons 1er Cru

If you like the noble austerity that Chablis is famed for, then this is a wine for you. Attractive summer-meadow plus honeycomb character on the nose and the front palate, then the combination of salty minerality and firm acidity charges through. Long, austere mineral finish, which we love.
