GRAND CRU "PREUSES"

Mineral on the nose, with good focus of **wet stones**, **chalky seashells** and **nectarines**. Crisp but pretty voluminous on the palate, with medium- to full-bodied and a saline, lengthy finish. Drink or hold.

GRAND CRU "BLANCHOT"

Salted lemon, sea shells and a touch of **cream** and **mineral**. A slightly simpler Blanchot but well balanced, with medium body and sufficient mid-palate substance and length. Drink or hold.

1ER CRU "MONT DE MILIEU"

This shows good depth of **wet stone minerality**. The nose is deeper and a bit more precise, with **chalky lime zest** and **crushed eggshells**. Leesy substances with subtle phenolics on the palate, with good volume, minerality and crunch. Pretty long. Drink or hold.

1ER CRU "MONTÉE DE
TONNERRE"

Perfumed **lemon citrus**, sliced **nectarine**, **white blossoms** and **mineral** on the nose. Medium-bodied, with crisp fruit and a chalky, long finish. Drink or hold.

1ER CRU "FOURCHAUME"

Scented, **peary nose** with a touch of **white blossoms** and **mineral**. Crisp and lightly saline, with a medium body and a lightly salty, phenolic finish. Drink or hold.

1ER CRU "CÔTE DE LÉCHET"

Mineral nose with seashells, **white nectarines** and **lime**. Medium-bodied with crisp, bright acidity and a limpid finish. 100% stainless steel tanks. Drink now.

Slightly leesy nose with a richer palate. Some **white nuts** with a lactic touch and **white fruit**. Medium-bodied, with fresh acidity and a lightly creamy finish. 100% stainless steel tanks. Drink now.

1ER CRU "VAILLONS"

Mineral and refreshing nose with sliced **apples** and a touch of **saline** character. Medium-bodied, with crisp fruit and a lightly saline finish. Drink now.

Salted lime and **seashells** on the nose, with a touch of **nectarine**. Medium-bodied with crisp acidity and a lightly salty, long finish. Grapes from the domaine with some oak in it. Drink or hold.

"BAS DE CHAPELOT"

Peary, flinty nose delivers freshness with a bit of **lime** and sliced **apples**. Crisp and simple with subtle phenolics at the end. A good aperitif. 65% stainless-steel tanks and the rest 3-5-year-old barrels. Drink now.
