Chablis Grand Cru "Blanchot"

A lot of summer-meadow and some oystershell aromas here. A sophisticated Chablis with a lot of underplayed power. A long elegant, supple and almost silky finish.

Chablis Grand Cru "Preuses" Ripe and bold but with

great freshness. This is an imposing and elegant wine with a rich lemon-tart character. Flinty and salty, a very long, super-elegant finish.



Chablis 1er Cru "Montée de Tonnerre"

I love the aromas of subtle white fruits, candied lemons and flowers. Concentrated and racy. It also has a lot of depth at the super-mineral finish that goes on and on.



Chablis 1er Cru "Mont de Milieu"

This is an impressive Premier Cru Chablis that has a lot of charm. It also has a serious structure and a very long, clean, lemony finish. The minerality creeps up on you right at the back.

Chablis 1er Cru "Fourchaume"

I love this wine's exuberant fruit salad and floral nose. On the palate, it's brimming with fruit. And then the fresh minerality charges through on the very clean finish.



Chablis 1er Cru "Vaillons"

A sophisticated Chablis with real concentration and sophistication. The citrus, floral and delicate, smoky notes are wrapped around a firm, mineral core. A long and rather complete finish.



If you're looking for the elegance for which Chablis are famous for, here it is. This has great balance of citrus and flinty characteristics. Good depth but only medium body. A long and rather complex finish.
